Cokal Limited (ASX: CKA) – Request for trading halt

Cokal Limited (**Company**) requests a trading halt in respect of its shares from the commencement of trading on Wednesday, 30 November 2016.

The trading halt is requested pending the announcement by the Company regarding information relating to the Platinum Group, the Company's largest debt holder, that has recently been brought to the Company's attention.

In accordance with Listing Rule 17.1, the Company advises:

1. the trading halt is necessary for the Company to make an announcement to the market in relation to the regarding the Platinum Group;
2. the trading halt should remain in place until the commencement of trading on Friday, 2 December 2016 unless before that time the Company makes an announcement regarding the Platinum Group or requests that the trading halt be lifted; and
3. the Company is not aware of any reason why the trading halt should not be granted or any other information necessary to inform the market about the trading halt.
